## Scholarships

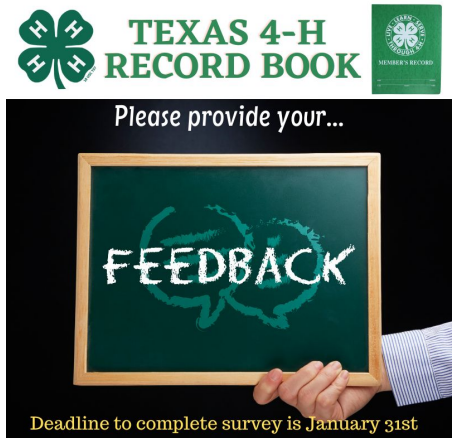
