We will need help on Saturday, October 2 to peel potatoes beginning at 7 a.m. at the K.C.Hall. Help is also needed on Sunday, October 3 to serve plates from 10:00 to 11:30, 11:30 to 1:00 and 1:00 to end. Please call the Extension Office to sign up to work. To be eligible to apply for the county awards, members must either sell 20 tickets or work a shift.

Remember that each club is responsible for providing cookies for dessert. These should be packaged before they are brought to the hall by 9:30 a.m. on October 3. ALL DESSERTS SHOULD BE HOMEMADE COOKIES THAT ARE AT LEAST 3 INCHES IN SIZE. COOKIES ARE TO BE PACKAGE TWO PER BAG. EACH CLUB MUST PROVIDE 120 PACKAGES OF COOKIES.
