2022-23 Enrollment

Enrollment does not open for the new year until August 15th. If you are enrolling a third grade member, please wait until September 1 when the 4-H year officially begins. All members must re-enroll. All adults are asked to complete the adult enrollment. Adults and youth who do not enroll are not covered by the 4-H liability insurance. Additionally, adults who do not enroll are unable to serve as chaperones and participate in District and State level events. The adult enrollment includes a criminal background check and safety trainings that help provide protections for the youth in our program. When enrolling, members will need to pay the enrollment fees with a credit card. Adults may pay with card or those who select the "pay by check" option will have their \$10 fee paid by Lavaca County 4-H. We will not be writing reimbursements for adult enrollments paid by card.

State Fair of Texas

Youth Livestock and Contest entries will be made online by parent/guardians through the online parent portal. Both the exhibitor and parent/guardian will be required to electronically sign the Release and Liability Signature form. A W9 including the youth exhibitor's social security number and signature is required at time of entry and may be completed electronically. Entries made by a parent/guardian must then be approved and submitted to State Fair by CEA/AST. Youth Livestock and Contest (and their uploaded required materials) entries must also be approved and submitted by CEA/AST. Entries are due on the portal by August 12. YOUTH GRILL-OFF RULES. SCHEDULE & PERMISSION

The Youth Grill-Off is a state-wide team BBQ burger cook-off contest organized by cooperative efforts of the Luling Foundation and tri-county Texas A&M AgriLife Extension offices of Caldwell, Gonzales & Guadalupe County. The Youth Grill-Off will take place on Saturday, September 10, 2022 at the Luling Foundation Farm's (LFF) Demonstration Barn located at 523 S. Mulberry, Luling, Texas 78648. This contest is for youth ages 3rd through 12th grade consisting of 2-3 youth per team of the same age category. Contestant age group categories are as follows: JR Division: 3rd - 7th Grade, SR Division: 8th - 12th Grade. *Entry Fee will be \$20/Team (Non-Refundable) and will be open to the first 30 team entries. Entry deadline is August 29, 2022; entries received after places have been filled will be put on a waiting list. Teams will be provided with Luling Foundation ground Angus beef, an Old Smokey BBQ grill and charcoal (**See itemized list below for complete list of what to bring and what will be provided). Teams will have 1 hour and 15 minutes to cook a burger patty and will be judged on taste, appearance, quality and creativity (judges will only eat the BEEF). Details of official rules will be discussed at the Chef Meeting at 9 AM (See Schedule below). Designated adult volunteers will light each grill and oversee each team. Parents will not be allowed in the allotted competition area but will be able to view the event. Each team will have one pound of ground beef provided and they will make 2-4 burgers; one beef patty will be judged and the others are for the team and their family to enjoy. There will be a complimentary "Table of Fixins" Condiment Bar for participants and their families to build their own burgers for lunch. Each grill-off team be allowed to take the Old Smokey BBQ cooker home. For more information, call the Luling Foundation office - 830-875-2438.
