## Attention All Livestock Exhibitors

It is the responsibility of each 4-Her to read, understand, and follow the rules of each activity they participate in. This especially holds true for local and major livestock shows, as consequences for breaking the rules can be quite significant. Please contact the Extension Office if questions should arise.

#### Medications:

4-H livestock exhibitors should be aware of the withdrawal times on medications and medicated feeds being given to show animals. Technically withdrawal time should be calculated from the time the animal arrives at the show. Please contact your veterinarian or feed dealer if there are any questions. Animals with illegal chemicals found in their system will be disqualified.

#### Scales:

Lavaca County 4-H has two scales for weighing swine, lambs and goats that can be checked out. Please call the Extension Office to book a scale. Please remember when you transport the scale, it must be locked down. This keeps the cables from breaking. Also make sure you clean the scale before returning it to the 4-H building. **PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT BRING ANIMALS INTO THE 4-H BUILDING.** 

#### Clippers:

Lavaca County 4-H has animal clippers that can be checked out. Please call the Extension Office to book them. Clippers are checked out without blades. It is each families responsibility to have blades for their projects. Below is a list of suggested blades to purchase for use on the 4-H clippers

#### Steers (slick shear):

Oster Clipmaster-83/84AU

#### Goats:

Lister Cover Cote blades

#### Lambs:

Lister 2241 A2S Surgical or Fine

#### Swine

Andis #10 blade to be used with guards

Record Book Corner: Section III - Community Service - "I pledge my hands to larger service" -how are you serving others? If you are a junior or an intermediate, you get 15 entries in this section.

Seniors have 25. Only those things that you do as a part of 4-H community service belongs here. Involvement in scouts, FFA, other school, youth organizations, and church belong in section VI. If you are in third through fifth grade you can include this year and two previous years.

Sixth grade and up may include this year and three previous years.

Always list the current year first and go backward.

Your current year (unless you have extenuating

circumstances like COVID) should have more than the previous as you are trying to show how you have grown and increased involvement.

Pro Tip: Make a note of how many people you are helping and how. For example, if you were one of the members who helped make goody bags for Festival of Lights your entry might look like this:

Year Role Activity Importance or Impact
2021-22 M Worked as a team member to
Make Goody Bags for Santa
Claus at Hallettsville Festival
Of Lights.

Importance or Impact
Spent 1 ½ hours making
600 bags from donations
provided by the community
to the city of Hallettsville.

#### What does Role mean?

Y -you did it on your own. For example cleaning out your closet and donating your clothing.

M-You were part of a group. All of the clubs complete community service, some at every meeting. Remember all of those things that you do. Have you brought a donation to a meeting, helped decorate a sign or made cards, etc.???

P - As you get older in 4-H you want to look for opportunities to take Primary Leadership in Community Service. What ideas have you come up with and gotten others to do with you?

Our county contest uses the categories and rules from the State Photography contest. For county you may enter one picture per category. On the county level, you will submit an 8x10 print with your name, grade, and category noted on the back. Pictures that place first advance, so it is important that you remember which pictures you submit in which category as you will enter District or State (depending on your age level) digitally. The County deadline has not been set, as we are waiting on the District deadline. Plan for the pictures to be due close to the beginning of February.

#### NATURAL RESOURCES PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

We are excited to announce a brand new state-level photography contest open to junior, intermediate, and senior members that will focus solely on the Natural Resource project areas. Here are a few key points:

- Open contest (no qualifying required) to all counties
- Open to juniors, intermediate, and senior age divisions
- 10 Natural Resource themed categories
- Same scoring matrix and general rules as the state contest
- Entry timeline is December 1-15
