Lamb and Goat tags – August 18 Swine tags – August 25 Heifer Tags – August 25 Broiler Orders – September 1

\*\*NEW\*\* All state validated heifers will be tagged similar to steers. This will bring the heifer validation program in line with breeding sheep, breeding goats, and breeding gilts. Please order tags accordingly. This is a change from the heifer UINs where you were charged based on animals validated, not ordered. Those planning to show a heifer at any major livestock

**show must order and pay for a tag by the deadline.** Please order accurately. No refunds will be given for unused tags. This is the last opportunity to validate a heifer for the 2024 major shows. #### **State Fair of Texas**



Youth Livestock and Contest entries will be made online by parent/guardians through the online parent portal. Both the exhibitor and parent/guardian will be required to electronically sign the Release and Liability Signature form. A W9 including the youth exhibitor's social security number and signature is required at time of entry and may be completed electronically. Entries made by a parent/guardian must then be approved and submitted to State Fair by CEA/AST. Youth Livestock and Contest (and their uploaded required materials) entries must

also be approved and submitted by CEA/AST. **Entries are due on the portal by August 18**. This is our county deadline to ensure enough time for approval and submission by the CEA/AST deadline. The entry portal can be found at <a href="https://bigtex.com">https://bigtex.com</a>
