

HALLTTSVILLE JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SHOW SCHOLARSHIP

Minimum Criteria

The HJLS Scholarship is an award to recognize outstanding accomplishments and leadership of HJLS exhibitors graduating from high school and pursuing further education. The following criteria are recommended as minimum only. Any exhibitor not meeting these criteria will not be considered for the award.

The HJLS exhibitor must be a senior year in high school. If there are no eligible members in this classification, then no scholarship will be awarded.

Applicant must have exhibited a project at the Hallettsville Junior Livestock Show at least four (4) years including the current year.

The HJLS Scholarship will be presented to the most deserving young person, without regard to gender.

The number of scholarships and amounts awarded will be evaluated on an annual basis according to available funds.

Applications are due to the Extension Office or Ag Science Teacher by April 1, 2024.

Scholarship recipients will need to provide proof of college enrollment by May 31, 2024 to receive their scholarship money.
